This project is exploring the Right to Participation in Cultural Life, with a particular emphasis on what the realisation of this right looks like for people who due to fraility or advancement of dementia, may benefit from adaptive musical interactions.

This workshop explores the possibility of flexible, person-centred, adaptive musical engagement - moving beyond the model of a concert and audience. Instead, the musician becomes mobile throughout the setting - bringing the music to small groups and individuals, and creating interactive, communicative, shared 'musical moments', for as long as the moment lasts.

We will explore the additional skillset needed to work sensitively in these environments: to read and respond to individuals, and build a musical 'toolbox' of responses.

Workshop 2: June 27th 2-4pm

The second workshop will be more discussion based, where we will share experiences, and explore and identify what further steps may be needed to develop and encourage this practice, and practitioners.

Dr Jane Bentley has over 20 years experience of working with people with dementia - and is the project leader for the Scottish Chamber Orchestra's 'Reconnect' project in hospitals.
